1. Capitalize the first word of every sentence.

<u>We</u> left after the party. <u>By</u> that time, it had started to rain. <u>The</u> teacher gave four assignments. <u>They</u> were very easy for us.

2. Capitalize the first word of a <u>sentence</u> in a direct quotation.


Tom said, "<u>Math</u> requires hard work." "<u>The</u> teacher gave four assignments," said Mary. "<u>Leave</u> now," said Joan. "<u>The</u> bus is on its way."

- 3. A. Capitalize the first word in the closing of a letter.
 - B. Capitalize the first, last, and all important words in the salutation (opening) of a letter.

4. Capitalize a specific region of the country.

We live in the $\underline{\mathbf{E}}$ ast. We love the $\underline{\mathbf{S}}$ outhwest.



5. Capitalize the first, last, and all important words in titles of books, magazines, plays, stories, poems, articles, movies, paintings, and other works of art.



The words *a*, *an*, *the*, and prepositions and conjunctions under five letters are <u>not</u> capitalized unless they are first or last words.

She read <u>The Bridges of Madison County</u>. I saw <u>Return of the Jedi</u> at the Rave Theater. Bill enjoys reading <u>Sports Illustrated</u>.

6. Capitalize proper nouns, including initials.

Proper nouns name <u>specific</u> people, places, or things. They are always capitalized. Common nouns are general names and are not capitalized unless they begin a sentence, begin a direct quotation, or are included in a title.

Do <u>not</u> capitalize seasons of the year (summer, winter, spring, or fall) unless they begin a sentence or are personified (Old Man Winter).
